Reference is made to your letter received on March 31, 2010 requesting that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS), and National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) suspend further review of the permit application to construct eleven emergent rubble mound breakwaters located in the Atlantic Ocean, off of Singer Island, in Palm Beach County, Florida. Your request to suspend the permit review is hereby granted. The Corps will expedite review of the alternative design when submitted, and will request that our federal partners do the same.
